## MInkluWB Dissemination Conference University of Sarajevo 15-16 February 2018

**Project**: MInkluWB is a DAAD-financed project that supports the establishment of training-based and curricular embedded peer mentoring in study programmes for business and economics addressing the needs of underrepresented student groups. Since the start of the project in March 2017 at all three main partner universities pilot mentoring groups or tandems have been started.

Consortium: Main partners of the consortium are University of Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina, South East European University in Tetovo, Macedonia (FYROM) and University of Niš, Serbia. Supporting partners are University of Paderborn, Germany, Libertas International University, Croatia and University of Ljubljana, Slovenia. Additionally, NGOs are involved namely ArbeiterKind.de from Germany, Association of disabled persons from Niš, Serbia, Association for Education MLADIINFO International from Skopje, Macedonia and Shared Society and Values Foundation from Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina
